Service Fraction

The exact years/months of service credit charged to your employer account; .083 equals one month of service. Decimal fractions allow IMRF to split a month of service between or among employers when a member earns concurrent service (reported by more than one employer for the same month). Concurrent service is indicated by a 'C' next to the service fraction.

Type of Wages

Tax Deferred: wages reported by the employer, most members' wage type is tax deferred.
Previously Taxed: stipend reported by the employer.
Seasonal Leave: no wages reported, member on seasonal leave.
Irregularly Paid: no wages reported; member irregularly paid.
Benefit Protection Leave, Omitted, Reinstated, etc: member purchased past service that occurred in 2007.

Disability Wages

Wages recorded for a member receiving IMRF disability benefits. Used to calculate a future pension if the wages occur during member's final rate of earnings (FRE) period. If the FRE period includes months with both employer reported wages and disability wages, IMRF uses the higher amount to determine the FRE.
