## **Senate Bill 2104:**

Commerce Commission Officer Transfers

## Proposed Change in the Law

In the provisions applicable to IMRF, the bill would add Commerce Commission police officers to the list of active State Employees' Retirement System (SERS) members who can transfer IMRF service earned as a law enforcement officer to SERS. It makes no changes to the requirements or procedures for these transfers. The bill also makes similar changes to transfers from a Downstate Fire (Article 4) fund or the Cook County pension system to SERS.

## Reasons for Position

This bill includes transfer provisions requested by various members of the pension funds. It does not make any changes to the amount that can be transferred from IMRF to SERS nor to how such transfers are made, but rather only adds an additional police officer group to those eligible to make the transfer.
