Suspended	Wages

ROUTE TO:

Suspended wages occur when reported wages and contributions cannot be properly credited to a member's account. Suspended wages not only affect your employer's IMRF account, they can also affect the accuracy of the information provided to your employees on their annual IMRF Member Statements and their benefit amounts.

Causes of suspended wages

Suspended wages most often occur when:

- Wages and contributions are reported for a member who <u>has not</u> yet been enrolled in IMRF. To correct this, enroll the member using <u>Employer Access</u>; remember to provide the correct enrollment date. Members who have suspended wages because they have not been enrolled in IMRF will not receive their annual Member Statement.
- Wages and contributions are reported for an employee who <u>should not</u> be enrolled in IMRF. Correct this by "backing out" the wages and contributions using an Employer Access wage adjustment. Both the member and employer contribution amounts will be credited to your employer's account *and you will need to reimburse the employee*.
- Wages and contributions are reported for a member using a different Social Security number than provided at enrollment. Correct this by contacting IMRF using the *exclusive employer-only phone*, 1-800-728-7971.
- Wages and contributions for a terminated member are reported later than the calendar month <u>following</u> the member's reported termination date. This is never allowed. Correct this scenario by either:
 - 1. "Backing out" the wages through an Employer Access wage adjustment, or
 - 2. If the termination date was incorrect, submitting a revised online termination form.
